*And let’s do it in the middle of Rush Hour traffic!*

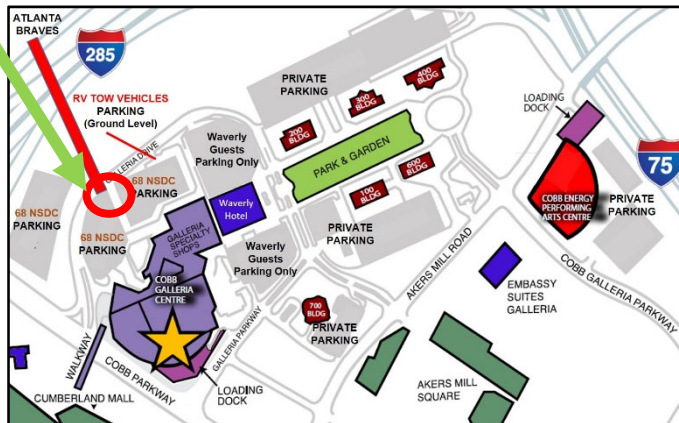
