A NIGHT AT STONE MOUNTAIN

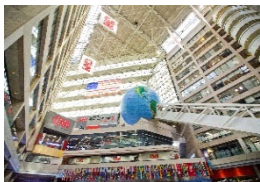

THE ANTEBELLUM TRAIL

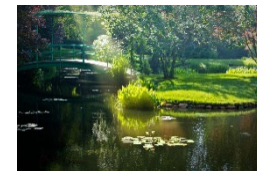

DAVID J. SENCER MUSEUM

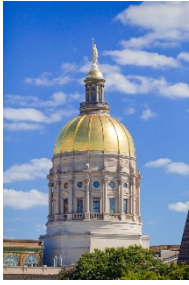
