

A Night at Stone Mountain

Our convention week begins with an evening of fun at Georgia's #1 attraction. Your guide and motor coach will meet you at your hotel to depart for **Georgia's Stone Mountain Park**, which is THE place to spend a warm summer night in Atlanta. "The Rock" is the largest exposed mass of granite in the world, and it is thought to be over 300 million years old. It stands 825 feet high and covers 583 acres, and it seems to grow every year as the earth erodes around it.

Our tour begins with a driving tour around a portion of the park's 3,200 acres and a visit to the Quarrying Exhibit. During the Civil War, granite from the mountain was used for tombstones, and later for paving streets and making curb stones. Today, Stone Mountain granite has been used for construction projects throughout the world, including the locks of the Panama Canal, the U.S. Capitol Building, the Imperial Hotel in Tokyo, and the University of Havana in Cuba.

Each person will receive a Twilight Pass which offers free admission to your choice of the park's attractions. Choose from the tram ride to the top of the mountain, the train ride around the mountain, the 18-building Plantation complex, or one of several museums. You will also have time to browse in Crossroads, Stone Mountain's new Old Town.

Dinner this evening will be at the Stone Mountain Inn or a catered buffet at Memorial Hall.

In the summertime, when the sun goes down, something magical happens at Stone Mountain. At dusk, the face of the mountain comes alive with the **Stone Mountain Laser Show!** The Lasershow Spectacular in Mountainvision® is a not-to-be-missed Atlanta tradition that will wow you with state-of-the-art digital graphics and awe-inspiring effects. The Lasershow features lights, iconic music, lasers and epic fireworks. Plus, three flame cannons add a punch to the show by sending a trio of flames nearly one-hundred feet into the air. You



will enjoy the show from the comfort of our reserve seating, with an outstanding view of the mountain, its famous Confederate Memorial Carving, and the world's longest running Lasershow.

The tour price of \$97 per person includes deluxe motor coach transportation, Twilight Pass to Stone Mountain attractions, buffet dinner, reserved seat at LaserShow, and Tour Guide Services. Light jacket might be needed!
